GENERAL

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Application 5959 was filed by Sylvain Siard on January 27, 1920 for 5.6 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is the underground water of Pleasant Valley and the point of diversion is described as being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T. 28N., R. 38E., M.D.B.&M. The 560 acres described under the place of use are within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, T. 28N., R. 38E., M.D.B.&M. The 560 acres described under the place of use are within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 26, T. 28N., R. 38E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office on August 8, 1968, by certified mail, to the applicant requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. A return receipt card signed by Harold Hager was returned to this office on August 13, 1968.

RULING

Application 5959 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
