R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 6051 was filed by Herman Reischke for permission to appropriate 3.2 c.f.s. of water from springs and water hole "Reischke Springs" for irrigation purposes.


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The proposed points of diversion are located within the  $W\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$  Section 1;  $SW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$  Section 1  $E\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$  Section 2,  $SE\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$  Section 2, all in T. 4 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 320 acres of land within the  $W\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$  Section 13,  $W\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$  Section 12, T. 4 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was protested by Echo Irrigation Co. on June 9, 1920 on the grounds that "said unknown springs and water holes and are tributary to the source--under permit 4533 of record in the name of Echo Irrigation Co. from Twin Springs slough." A letter dated September 27, 1968 was sent by Certified Mail to the Echo Irrigation Co. requesting additional information regarding their protest to this application. Said letter advised that this information must be submitted on or before October 26, 1968. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING

The protest against the granting of Application 6051 is herewith overruled on the grounds that the protestants, or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information necessary. A permit will be issued under Application 6051 upon receipt of the statutory permit fees and issued subject to any existing rights.
