RULING

GENERAL:

Application 7604 was filed on December 15, 1925, by Blanche M. Dilley to appropriate 0.25 cfs of water from two small springs for domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T18N., R20E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T18N., R20E., MDB&M. Application 7604 was protested on February 14, 1926, by the Nevada Steamboat Springs Company.

A letter was sent to the applicant on November 1, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 7604. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 7604 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest failed to submit additional information and approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
