

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 13138
IN NAME OF J. T. DUNKIN TO APPROPRIATE
UNDERGROUND WATER FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES
IN FISH LAKE VALLEY, ESMERALDA COUNTY,
NEVADA.

RULING

Application No. 13138 was filed November 1, 1949 by J. T. Dunkin to appropriate 4.0 c.f.s. of underground water at a point within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 35 E. for the irrigation of 320 acres of land in portions of Sections 19 and 20, T. 1 S., R. 35 E.

Protests to the granting of a permit under said application were filed by E. L. Cord on June 12, 1950, and by Rex B. Clark on July 3, 1950.


The land on which water was to be appurtenant was Government land and Applicant J. T. Dunkin filed a Desert Land Entry with the Nevada Land and Survey Office. On May 8, 1950 J. T. Dunkin withdrew his Desert Land Entry.

In view of the withdrawal by Applicant J. T. Dunkin of his land entry, it is apparent that he is no longer interested in his application to appropriate water for such lands and it could be denied.

RULING

Application No. 13138 in name of J. T. Dunkin to appropriate water is herewith denied on the grounds that the withdrawal of his land entry on which water was to be appurtenant under said application would indicate that he is no longer interested.
