GENERAL:


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Application 24150 was filed on September 27, 1967, by Donly Gray to appropriate 11.0 c.f.s. of water from Six Mile Canyon for mining and milling purposes. The proposed point of diversion is in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T. 17 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 31, T. 17 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M.

First notice requesting permit fees was mailed to the applicant on August 9, 1968. The final notice was sent to the applicant on September 10, 1968, by certified mail and a return receipt card signed by Donly Gray was received in this office September 12, 1968. A certified letter was sent to the applicant on November 25, 1968, stating that if the permit fees are not received by December 24, 1968, it will be mandatory for the State Engineer to cancel this application. A return receipt card signed by Henry Misener for Donly Gray was received in this office December 2, 1968. No permit fees have been received in response to these notices.

RULING

Application 24150 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the statutory permit fees as provided by NRS 533.435 after proper notice dated November 25, 1968.
