GENERAL:

Application 8135 was filed on May 19, 1927 by Edwin Van Riper for 2.0 c.f.s. of water for stockwatering purposes.

The proposed source is Little Indian Spring and has its proposed point of diversion and place of use within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T. 40 N., R. 22 E. unsurveyed.

A letter was sent to the owner of record and the Federal Land Bank of Berkeley who holds this application for security purposes by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application.

A letter, dated December 26, 1968, signed by Gunnar F. Halle, Sr. Engineer, appraiser for the Federal Land Bank of Berkeley stated that the Federal Land Bank of Berkeley held this application for security purposes only and has no intention of perfecting this right. The letter sent to the owner of record of this application was returned by the postal department stamped "unclaimed."

It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 8135 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
