GENERAL:

Application 8019 was filed on March 2, 1927 by Francis Cutting Company, a Corp. to change the manner of use of Permit No. 7737. The amount of water to be changed is 0.5 c.f.s. from California Mill Spring No. 10 and is to be used for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.

Application 8020 was filed on March 2, 1927 by Francis Cutting Company, a Corp. to change the manner of use of Permit 7723. The amount of water desired to be changes is 0.5 c.f.s. and is to be used for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The source is California Mill Spring No. 9 and has the point of diversion and place of use within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 5, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.

Application 8021 was filed on March 2, 1927 by Francis Cutting Company, a Corp. to change the manner of use of Permit No. 7747. The amount of water desired to be changed is 0.5 c.f.s. and is to be used for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The source is California Mill Spring No. 19 and has its point of diversion and place of use within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.


