RULING

GENERAL:

63
Application 8089 was filed on April 7, 1927, by Harry E. Webb to appropriate ten miners inches of water from small springs for stockwatering (2,500 sheep and 50 cattle) purposes from April 1st to October 15th of each year. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T31N., R53E., MDB&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed on May 15, 1927, by J. P. Raine.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 30, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 8089. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "Addressee Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 8089 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be determined to the public welfare.
