FILED BY ERNEST SWAN TO APPROPRIATE)
WATER FROM A LAKE (NAME UNKNOWN)) R U L I N G
IN HUMBOLDT COUNTY, NEVADA)

GENERAL:

Application 4646 was filed on October 18, 1917 by Ernest Swan to appropriate 2.0 cfs of water from a lake (name unknown) for irrigation (200 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, T. 34 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, T. 35 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B.&M. Period of use for irrigation to begin about May 1st and end about September 15th of each year. Protest to the granting of Application 4646 was filed on November 27, 1917 by the Golconda Cattle Company.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 30, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 4646. The letter was returned by the post office department stamped "Unclaimed". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 4646 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
