R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 8636 was filed on July 22, 1928, by the Steptoe Livestock Company to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from an un-named spring for stockwatering (5,000 sheep) and domestic purposes from May 1st to November 1st of each year. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 40 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed on November 28, 1928, by S. J. and S. C. Weeks.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 31, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 8636. The certified mail return receipt card was received in this office on January 3, 1969.

RULING

Application 8636 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
