FILED BY ARTHUR H. BROWN TO)
APPROPRIATE WATER FROM CANYON) R U L I N G
SPRING IN ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA)

GENERAL:

Application 9181 was filed by Arthur H. Brown on December 6, 1929 to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Canyon Spring for stockwatering (4,000 sheep and 1,500 cattle) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, T. 28 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed on October 15, 1930 by J. Leland Hylton.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 2, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 9181. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "Unknown." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 9181 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
