RULING

GENERAL:



On November 9, 1953, Richard E. Danielson, Jr., filed Application 15377 to change the point of diversion and place of use of 1.25 cfs of underground water heretofore claimed under a vested right and used for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion claimed under a vested right is in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 1, T22S., R61E., MDB&M., and the point of diversion under Application 15377 was to be in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  said Section 1. The place of use claimed under a vested right is 80 acres in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  said Section 1 and the place of use under Application 15377 is 120 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$  and W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  said Section 1. No proof of appropriation of water has been filed to substantiate the claim of vested right that Application 15377 proposed to change.

On October 11, 1968, a letter was sent to the applicant requesting additional information. The letter was returned "Unclaimed".

RULING

Application 15377 is hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit information requested and the approval of Application 15377 without this information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
