GENERAL


Application 6940 was filed by Silver Circle Mining Company on July 14, 1923, to appropriate 2/7 c.f.s. of water from Cold Springs, a tributary of Burnt Creek for domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T. 40 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T. 40 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 24, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 6940. The certified mail return receipt card was received in this office on February 4, 1969. The original letter dated January 24, 1969, was returned on February 4, 1969, with a note added stating that the Silver Circle Mining Company no longer exists.

RULING

Application 6940 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
