R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 6898 was filed by Peter Decker on May 9, 1923, to appropriate 100 acre feet of water from the Humboldt River for irrigation (100 acres) purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T. 25 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2, T. 24 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B.&M.

Protests to the granting of this were filed by Lovelock Lands, Incorporated on June 25, 1923, and by J. B. Daniel on July 15, 1923.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 23, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 6898. This letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked: "Deceased." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

Application 6898 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
