R U L I N G

GENERAL:

179 Application 8165 was filed by James Doutre on June 11, 1927, for permission to appropriate 0.025 c.f.s. of water from Camp Spring for watering of 2,000 head of sheep. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, T. 25 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.


This application was ready for action for the issuance of a permit on November 7, 1927.

The Bureau of Land Management was contacted by letter, dated February 20, 1969, requesting information as to the range user in the area of this application; their reply, dated March 4, 1969, states that the applicant does not have a range allotment in the area covered by this application.

RULING

Application 8165 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant does not have a range allotment for the area covered by this application, and granting of a permit under this application without a range allotment would be detrimental to the public welfare.
