GENERAL:

Application 4570 was filed by Union Land and Cattle Company on September 8, 1917 to appropriate 200.0 c.f.s. of water from the West Walker River for irrigation (14,520 acres), stockwatering and domestic purposes.


The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 8 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., in California. The place of use is described as within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 16; Sections 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26; S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35; Section 36 all in T. 10 N., R. 22 E.; Sections 18 and 19; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17; W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 20, Sections 30 and 31, all in T. 10 N., R. 23 E.; Sections 1 and 2, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3; fractional W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 10; NE $\frac{1}{4}$, fractional SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, Sections 11, 12, 13, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, fractional NW $\frac{1}{4}$, fractional SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14; NE $\frac{1}{4}$, fractional NW $\frac{1}{4}$; fractional SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, all in T. 9 N., R. 22 E.; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, all in T. 9 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 17, 1969 requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 4570. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Unknown".
