RULING

GENERAL:

Application 5258 was filed by Joe Ponte on September 24, 1918, to appropriate 2.0 cfs of water from the Main Walker River for irrigation (200 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T13N., R25E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T14N., R25E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on March 18, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5258. This office was advised on April 9, 1969, by Mr. Ralph Hash, son-in-law to Joe Ponte, that the property had been sold and that Mr. Ponte was no longer interested in Application 5258.

RULING

Application 5258 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
