RULING

GENERAL:


107 Application 5363 was filed by Charles A. Hendel on January 20, 1919, to appropriate 195.60 cfs or 78,240 acre-feet of water from the West Walker River for irrigation (19,560 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T11N., R23E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 4, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 23, Sections 24 to 26 inclusive, T11N., R23E., Sections 28 and 33, T12N., R23E., W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 1, Sections 2 to 8 inclusive, T11N., R24E., Section 5, W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 7, Sections 17 to 19 inclusive, W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 20, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, Sections 28 to 34 inclusive, W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 35, T12N., R24E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on March 18, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5363. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Unclaimed - Addressee unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5363 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
