GENERAL

(11) Application 10651 was filed by Gus Williams and Wilbur and F. J. Seyden on April 21, 1941, to appropriate 15.0 c.f.s. of water from Perazzi Slough for irrigation (1,500 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, T.15N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within portions of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, T.15N., R.24E., and portions of Sections 15, 16, 20 and 21, T.15N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

Protests to the granting of this application were filed by F. M. Fulstone on December 16, 1941, and by the Gallagher Brothers on December 23, 1941, and by the Walker River Irrigation District on December 29, 1941.

Application 10651 now stands in the name of Gus Williams, F. J. Seyden and Joseph A. and William M. Frade, as the owners of record by proper assignment filed in this office.

A letter was sent to the owners of record on March 24, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 10651. The letter to Gus Williams was returned by the Post Office Department marked: "Deceased 20 years." The certified mail return receipt cards were returned to this office on March 26, 1969, from letter addressed to F. J. Seyden, and on March 27, 1969, from letter addressed to Joseph A. and William M. Frade.

RULING

Application 10651 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owners of record, or their successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
