GENERAL:

Application 5535 was filed by Kate Martinez on June 12, 1919 to appropriate 0.4 c.f.s. of water from Indian Springs. The point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

Protest to the granting of this application was filed by Eugene Scossa on August 19, 1919.

A letter was sent to the applicant on November 17, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5535. No reply or expression of interest has been received to this inquiry.

RULING

Application 5535 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
