GENERAL:


Application No. 8867 was filed by George G. Hussman on April 18, 1929 to appropriate 400 acre-feet of water from East Carson River. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10; E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed by The Truckee-Carson Irrigation District on June 13, 1929 and Carson Valley Users on June 21, 1929.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 11, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application No. 8867. No reply or expression of interest was received to this request.

RULING

Application No. 8867 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
