R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 4335 was filed, by David T. Cochran on March 1, 1917, for permission to appropriate 0.25 cfs of water from Wood Canyon for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T. 28 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section 27. Protests were filed by F. J. Howard and L. A. Friedman on April 4, 1917 and by Nevada Packard Mines Company on May 19, 1917. This application was assigned to L. A. Friedman on August 24, 1917.

A letter, dated February 27, 1970, was sent to the owner of record by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned by the Post Office Department, stamped "deceased". It is the responsibility of the owner of record or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 4335 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record and successors in interest failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
