General:

Application 8261 was filed by Elizabeth S. Barndt on August 4, 1927 for permission to appropriate 0.025 c.f.s. of water from Little Cow Canyon Creek for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T. 9 N., R. 50 E., unsurveyed.

An informal protest was filed by J. B. Sorhouet on March 16, 1928.


This application was ready for action January 25, 1927. This application was assigned to Helen D. Williams and Helen D. Williams as guardian of Joseph T. Williams, Jr. and Roger Carl Williams on May 10, 1932.

The owners of record were notified by certified mail on March 25, 1970 that it would be necessary to submit a notice of continued interest in this application and also submit evidence that they could beneficially use the water for the purpose applied for. This letter was returned stamped: "Moved, left no address" by the Post Office Department.

Ruling

Application 8261 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owners of record failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
