

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION 11684)
FILED BY JOHN AND ALICE ROSS TO)
APPROPRIATE WATER FROM UNNAMED SPRING)
AND SEEPAGE IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA)

R U L I N G

General:

Application 11684 was filed by John and Alice Ross on September 9, 1946 to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of water from Unnamed Spring and Seepage. The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B &M. The place of use is described as within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.


Protest to the granting of this application was filed by First National Bank of Nevada, et. al. and Neva Winters Sauer, et. al. on November 20, 1946 and October 21, 1946.

A letter was sent to the applicants on November 6, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 11684. On January 28, 1970 a letter was received from Mr. Charles M. Murphy, Attorney-at-Law indicating that Mr. and Mrs. John Ross had abandoned all intent of developing the waters under Application 11684. No reply or expression of interest has been received from the applicants. On March 19, 1970 another certified letter was forwarded requesting information. As of the date of this ruling, no reply or expression of interest has been received.

RULING

Application 11684 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
