RULING

GENERAL:


Application 17497 was filed by C-B Ranch Company on February 26, 1958, for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s of water from Tub Springs for stock watering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 7 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M. This application was informally protested by Westside Cattle Company on July 9, 1958.

A letter dated March 19, 1970, was sent to the applicant by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped "Unclaimed" by the Post Office Department. A letter dated February 27, 1970, was sent to the Bureau of Land Management requesting additional information regarding the range users in the area around this proposed point of diversion. Their reply dated March 4, 1970, states that Tub Springs is located in the Common Use Allotment and a list of users given did not include C-B Ranch Company.

RULING

Application 17497 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants failed to submit required information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application.
