R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 9169 was filed by F. E. Bush and F. H. Murphy on November 23, 1929, for permission to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Gravel Spring & Creek for stock watering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot 10) Sec. 35, T.43N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

Protests were filed under this application by Parman and Valerdi Co. on November 2, 1930, and Theodore Belzarena & Co. on December 14, 1930. No further action has been taken since that time.

A letter was sent to the applicants on April 8, 1970, by certified mail requesting information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped: "Deceased" by the Post Office Department.

RULING

Application 9169 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
