R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 7918 was filed, by John G. Taylor, on October 30, 1926 to appropriate 0.10 cfs of water from Unnamed Spring, "Taylor Spring", for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T. 36 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use within the same subdivision. The application proposes to water 40,000 sheep on a year around basis. This application was transferred to Allied Properties on November 25, 1954.


Application No. 7918 was protested on January 27, 1927 by W. M. Pettit.

Correspondence with the Bureau of Land Management indicates that the Allied Land and Livestock Corporation is one of the range users in the area of the spring under Application No. 7918. There are no existing rights of record on the source.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 7918 is herewith overruled on the grounds that there is unappropriated water at the source. A permit will be granted upon receipt of statutory permit fees subject to existing rights.
