R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 25722 was filed July 20, 1970, by Harvey W. Young to appropriate 0.25 cfs from an underground source located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., MDB&M. The use is quasi-municipal. The place of use is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., and the period of use is annual.


This application was protested on October 16, 1970, by the Ely Municipal Water Department, praying that the application be denied on the grounds, "Said underground well number 2 is in the close proximity of wells and springs owned by the Ely Municipal Water Department and the diversion from the proposed underground source would effect the ground water table thus effecting the flow of springs and flowing well."

A field investigation was conducted on November 18, 1970. It was discussed at that time that the well had been drilled, pump and motor installed and the water was being used for quasi-municipal purposes. It was also learned that the Ely Municipal Water Department could not serve the area owned by Mr. Young.

RULING

The protest to the granting of the permit to Application 25722 is herewith overruled on the grounds that the approval of this application will not adversely effect prior rights. A permit will be issued subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
