R U L I N G

GENERAL:

119 Application 8733 was filed by Thomas Griffin on October 4, 1928, for permission to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of water from Twin Springs for watering of 500 head of cattle and 25 horses. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28, T. 32 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This application was protested by Pete Abadie on January 19, 1929. A letter was sent to the protestant by certified mail on April 13, 1970, inquiring as to the continued interest in pursuing the protest. This letter was returned stamped, "unknown", by the Post Office Department.

This application is of record in the name of Charles J. Griffin's name and 3/4 interest in the names of Melvin and Rachel S. Jones.

Letters were sent by certified mail to the owners of record on June 11, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. Return receipts were received in this office June 15, 1970, and no reply has been received.

Application 8735 was filed by Thomas Griffin on October 24, 1928, for permission to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of water from Cleary Springs for watering 500 head of cattle and 25 horses. The location of the proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, T. 32 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was protested by Central Pacific Railway Company on January 2, 1929. A letter was sent by certified mail on April 13, 1970, to the protestants requesting notification of their continued interest in pursuing their protest. A return receipt was received in this office April 15, 1970. No reply has been received to this letter.

This application is of record in the name of Charles J. Griffin, $\frac{1}{4}$ interest, and Melvin and Rachel S. Jones, 3/4 interest. Letters were sent to the owners of record by certified mail on June 11, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before the permit could be issued under this application. Return receipts were received in this office on June 15, 1970. No reply has been received to these letters.

RULING

Applications 8733 and 8735 are hereby denied on the grounds that the owners of record failed to submit the required information necessary before permits could be issued under these applications.
