R U L I N G

GENERAL

An application for a well driller's license was received on August 19, 1971, with the statutory \$25.00 fee from T. C. Allen. Receipt No. 3411 was issued on August 27, 1971, to the applicant.

The names of five persons were submitted for reference on the application with incomplete addresses. A letter dated August 19, 1971, was forwarded to Mr. Allen requesting complete addresses for the persons submitted as references. No response was received to this request to Mr. Allen. A letter dated October 7, 1971, was forwarded to Dimick Drilling Company in an effort to contact Mr. Allen. The letter to Dimick Drilling Company was returned with the note "T. C. Allen is no longer in my employe and I do not have any further info. However, I paid for the license application (\$25.00) and I would appreciate the check being returned to me. Thank you. V. H. Dimick."

The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board at the December 17, 1971, meeting recommended denial of the application for a well driller's license by T. C. Allen on the grounds of an insufficient number of references having been received.

RULING

The application for a well driller's license filed by T. C. Allen is herewith denied on the grounds that insufficient references were received to determine that the applicant has had sufficient training and experience to qualify as a well driller.
