R U L I N G

GENERAL:

An application for a well driller's license was received on September 8, 1971 with the statutory \$25.00 fee from Elton Leslie Jones. Receipt No. 3409 was issued on September 8, 1971 to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to the persons listed on the application on September 8, 1971. References were received from three of the six persons listed on the application. Two of the three references received were unsatisfactory as they did not comment on the applicant's ability to drill wells for the development of water. The applicant was requested to submit additional names of persons having knowledge of his ability as a well driller by letter dated October 7, 1971. No response was received from Mr. Jones to this request for additional references.

The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board, at the December 17, 1971 meeting, recommended denial of the application for a well driller's license by Elton Leslie Jones on the grounds of insufficient and unsatisfactory references.

Ruling

The application for a well driller's license filed by Elton Leslie Jones is herewith denied on the grounds that insufficient and unsatisfactory references were received to determine that the applicant has had sufficient training and experience to qualify as a well driller.
