

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION FOR A)
WELL DRILLER'S LICENSE FILED ON) R U L I N G
JANUARY 31, 1972, BY JERRY K. CLARK.)

GENERAL

An application for a well driller's license was received on January 31, 1972, with the statutory \$25.00 fee from Jerry K. Clark, 104 Ocotillo, Henderson, Nevada. Receipt No. 3426 was issued on January 31, 1972, to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to persons listed on the application on January 31, 1972. References were received from three of the five persons listed on the application. Two of the three references received were unsatisfactory in recommending the applicant as a well driller.


The applicant was notified by certified mail on February 16, 1972, that the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board would consider his application at the March 8, 1972 meeting in Las Vegas and requested Mr. Clark to appear for an oral interview. The notice was returned to this office stamped "Unclaimed" by the Post Office Department. Mr. Clark failed to appear before the Advisory Board at the appointed time and did not contact this office to request the interview at another time. Board member M. E. McKinney stated that Mr. Clark was employed by him but that Mr. Clark had disappeared.

The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board at the March 8, 1972 meeting recommended denial of the application of Jerry K. Clark because of insufficient and unsatisfactory references.

RULING

The application for a well driller's license filed by Jerry K. Clark is herewith denied on the grounds that the references received do not indicate sufficient qualifications to be licensed as a well driller.
