

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 12125 )  
FILED BY BASIL BREWER AND GEORGE A. RILEY :  
TO APPROPRIATE WATER FROM AN UNDERGROUND : RULING  
SOURCE FOR STOCKWATERING PURPOSES. )

Application No. 12125 was filed on December 10, 1947 by Basil Brewer and George A. Riley to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for the watering of 500 cattle and 50 horses. The point of diversion and the place of use are to be in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T. 4 S., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was protested on September 7, 1948 by James M. Daniels and on September 25, 1948 by Nellie Coughlin, E. J. Shirley, S. M. Chiatovich and H. R. Humphrey.

RULING

The proposed point of diversion and place of use under Application No. 12125 are located within the boundaries of Grazing Leases, Serial Nos. Nev. 01589 and 01589A issued to Basil Brewer and George A. Riley by the Bureau of Land Management, Division of Grazing. Said leases have been assigned to Ernest M. Pellkofer.

The protests to the granting of Application No. 12125 are herewith overruled on grounds that the proposed stockwatering facilities are within the Grazing Lease of the Applicants, and are outside of any area leased to the Protestants.

A permit will be issued under this application upon receipt of the statutory fee.
