R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 26848 was filed on July 26, 1972, by National Geothermal Corporation of Nevada to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for industrial purposes. The point of diversion is described as being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T.19N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as Section 20, T.19N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.

The statutory required \$25.00 filing fee accompanied this application on July 26, 1972, in the form of a personal check under National Geothermal Resources Corporation (Receipt No. 89866). On August 16, 1972, the check was returned to the State Engineer's office by the First National Bank of Nevada with the notation "refer to maker." It appears that this was in error. The check should have been returned to the State Engineer's office because there was no endorsement by the State Engineer on the back of the check. The check apparently should have born the stamping "endorsement missing" instead of "refer to maker."

Application 26848 was cancelled on August 16, 1972, for failure of the applicant to submit the statutory filing fee for a new application.

RULING

The cancellation of Application 26848 is hereby rescinded and the processing of Application 26848 will proceed in conformance with the statutory procedure.
