R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27147 was filed on November 24, 1972 by Lee E. Glenn and Ream M. Armstrong to appropriate 0.20 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 34, T.19S, R.53E., M.D.B.& M. The proposed place of use is described as within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.& M. The period of use is to be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

The applicant states that the proposed water use will be for an eighty unit trailer park, office building, community recreation building and laundry building.

The proposed point of diversion is located on the alluvial fan in an area with prior existing water rights. An additional appropriation of groundwater in this critical area, where water levels have declined from 40 to 50 feet over the last fifteen years due to the demand on this resource, would adversely affect existing water rights.

RULING:

Application 27147 is herewith denied on the grounds that additional appropriation of groundwater in this area on the alluvial fan would adversely affect existing water rights.
