R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27478 was filed on May 16, 1973, to appropriate 0.07 c.f.s. from the waters of an underground source to be diverted in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31; T.15N., R.20E., and to be used for municipal water appropriation within portions of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6 T.14N., R.20E., an area comprising Fugi Park.

This application was protested on August 30, 1973, by Bertha V. Bruce on the following grounds: "I am making this protest in behalf of Mr. and Mrs. Martin Arraiz, who are buying the Oasis Trailer Haven under contract of sale. There is, at the present time, two wells which furnish the water for the Trailer Park. I feel the close proximity of this proposed well will effect the amount of water we now have. The above mentioned wells are filed with the Water Resources Division. Files 18535 and 18536."

The source of the proposed appropriation is an existing well eight inches in diameter by sixty feet deep. This existing well is approximately 5200 feet from the point of diversion described under Permit 18535 and approximately 5400 feet from the point of diversion described under Permit 18536.


OPINION:

It is our opinion that the granting of this application will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or otherwise be detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 27478 is hereby overruled on the grounds that its granting will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or otherwise be detrimental to the public welfare and a permit will be issued under this application upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
