R U L I N G

GENERAL

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was received in this office on August 15, 1973, together with the \$25.00 statutory filing fee from Glen S. Kunkel, Jr., P. O. Box 213, Dayton, Nevada 89403. Receipt No. 3842 for the \$25.00 fee was issued on August 15, 1973, to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to those four (4) persons or firms as listed on the application on August 15, 1973. Three responses were received to the requests for reference.

The applicant was advised by certified mail dated August 24, 1973, that a time was set on the agenda for him to appear for an oral interview before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board at the regular meeting scheduled for September 7, 1973. The applicant appeared before the Advisory Board as scheduled for an oral interview. The applicant stated that he had drilled three wells in Viet Nam while in the Army and had been working for W. M. Blain since April of this year.

The Advisory Board recommended denial of the application for a well driller's license by Glen S. Kunkel, Jr. on the grounds that the applicant did not have sufficient experience. In addition, the Advisory Board recommended that Mr. Kunkel reapply for a well driller's license after an additional six months of experience.

RULING

The application for a well driller's license filed by Glen S. Kunkel, Jr. is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant does not have sufficient experience to qualify as a well driller.
