R U L I N G

GENERAL

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was received in this office on July 12, 1973, together with the statutory \$25.00 filing fee from Gene Purdy, 1731 Sherwin Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada. Receipt No. 3840 for the \$25.00 fee was issued on July 12, 1973, to the applicant.

Mr. Purdy held Nevada Well Driller's License No. 715 issued on April 10, 1973, and which expired on June 30, 1973, for failure to submit an application for annual renewal with the statutory \$10.00 fee prior to June 30, 1973. This application was filed by Mr. Purdy to replace the expired well driller's license.

Mr. Purdy was advised by letter dated August 29, 1973, that his application for a well driller's license would be considered at the regular meeting of the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board scheduled on September 7, 1973. Also, the letter of August 29, 1973, requested additional well logs to be filed with the Las Vegas Branch Office of the Division of Water Resources for wells drilled before his license expired.

Mr. Stan Cavolick, the representative from the State Contractors Board attending the September 7, 1973, meeting of the Advisory Board, reported that Mr. Purdy drilled five wells under a partnership in Scott Enterprises and that two complaints would be filed by the State Contractors Board for contracting the drilling of wells without a contractor's license. The field investigation by the State Contractors Board reports wells contracted and drilled by the applicant after his well driller's license had expired on June 30, 1973.

Continued efforts by the Las Vegas Branch Office to acquire the five (5) well logs have been unsuccessful.

Failure by this driller to file proper well logs places the holder of a permit in the position of not being able to file a Proof of Completion of Work, thereby making the permit subject to cancellation.

The Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended the application for a well driller's license by Gene Purdy be denied on the grounds that the applicant had not complied with the rules and regulations of the State Engineer.

RULING

The application for a Nevada well driller's license filed by Gene Purdy is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit all well logs and has not complied with the rules and regulations of the State Engineer.
