R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27566 was filed on June 21, 1973 by the Frontier Enterprises, Inc. to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M. The place of use is described as within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M. The period of use is to be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

Under remarks the applicant states: "the primary purpose of this well and pipe system is for a standby to well under Permit No. 25728. No additional water over that granted under Permit No. 25728 is applied for. The place of use is the same as that for Permit No. 25728".

By letter dated December 4, 1973, Mr. Paul Lumos, Public Works Director, states that Carson City Water Department is in a position to provide the applicant with the necessary water service to the applicant upon payment of the necessary hookup charge and a monthly minimum on the meter as is customary with a standby service.

Under the provisions of NRS 534.120 (3) the State Engineer may deny applications to appropriate ground water for any purposes within a designated area when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality presently engaged in furnishing water to the inhabitants thereof.

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RULING

Application 27566 is herewith denied on the grounds that water service is available from an entity presently engaged in furnishing water and the granting would not be in the public interest.
