GENERAL:

Application 12257 was filed by Frank Alexis on February 11, 1948, for permission to appropriate 0.2 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.5S., R.37E., M.D.B. & M.

This application was protested by Brewer and Riley on June 3, 1948. A ruling was issued March 25, 1954, overruling the protest and granting the permit upon receipt of statutory permit fees.

A notice requesting permit fees was forwarded to the applicant on March 25, 1954 and another notice on July 29, 1954. No reply was received to these notices. A letter was forwarded to the applicant by certified mail on August 8, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt was received in this office on August 20, 1969. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING:

Application 12257 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the requested information necessary for a permit to be issued under this application.
