R U L I N G

General:

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was received in this office on August 20, 1974 with the statutory \$25.00 filing fee from George M. Curry, Box 16, Imlay, Nevada 89418. Receipt No. 4111 for the \$25.00 fee was issued on August 20, 1974 to George M. Curry.

Requests for references were forwarded to four (4) persons as listed on sheet attached to the application on August 20, 1974. Three (3) responses were received to the requests for reference, all of which were character references and made no reference to the applicant's ability as a well driller.

The applicant was advised by certified mail dated August 22, 1974 that a time was set on the agenda to appear for an oral interview before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board. The applicant appeared as scheduled before the Advisory Board and was questioned regarding his knowledge and experience as a well driller. The applicant stated that he had no experience as a well driller and that he only intended to drill wells on his own property to develop the land.

The Advisory Board recommended denial of the application by George M. Curry because of the lack of experience. Two members of the Advisory Board recommended the applicant work as a helper for at least six (6) months.

Ruling:

The application for a Nevada Well Driller's license filed by George M. Curry is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant lacks the experience to qualify as a well driller.
