R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 27920 was filed on November 26, 1973 by Ron Rudin Construction Company to appropriate 0.25 cfs of water from Cold Springs for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 1, T.18S., R.55E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as being within the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, T.18S., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  in Section 6, T.18S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. The period of use is January 1st to December 31st of each year. The applicant states that water is to be used to serve approximately 210 vacation lots. Records and observations indicate the flow from Cold Springs varies from 4.0 cfs in the spring to less than 0.5 cfs in the late fall. Existing water rights of record from Cold Springs include Permit 167, Certificate 524 for 7.0 cfs and Permit 14768, Certificate 4188 for 4.0 cfs of water.

RULING:

Application 27920 is herewith denied on the grounds that the source is fully appropriated and the granting would adversely affect prior existing water rights.
