GENERAL:

Application 29850 was filed on December 8, 1975, by B. A. Jackson or Mildred L. Jackson to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for commercial, mobile home park use. Water is to be diverted from its source at a point within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The proposed place of use is described as within the W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.M. The period of use is to be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The applicant states that water will be used for approximately 110 mobile home spaces on approximately 22 acres of land.

No protests were filed in the matter of Application 29850.

The perennial yield of the ground water reservoir in Cold Springs Valley has been estimated by the U. S. Geological Survey to be 500 acre-feet of ground water per year.


Permits have been issued in Cold Springs Valley in excess of the annual recharge.

Application 29126 filed by B. A. Jackson or Mildred L. Jackson on January 8, 1975 was denied by Ruling No. 2042 dated April 15, 1975 on the grounds that the granting of applications to appropriate additional ground water in Cold Springs Valley would adversely affect existing water rights.

RULING:

Application 29850 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of this application would adversely affect existing water rights and be detrimental to the public welfare.
