RULING

Description of Application:

Application No. 16806 was filed on December 7, 1955 by the Deius Ego Corporation to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of water from an unnamed spring for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion was described as being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T. 24 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use to be within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T. 24 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M. The period of use was to be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

A protest to the granting of this application was filed on March 1, 1956 by E. J. Bottomley on grounds that protestant has owned mining claims in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T. 24 N., R. 34 E., since 1939, and has used the waters of this spring by building dams and diverting the water for diamond drilling purposes, as well as camp site purposes for a period of over one year.

General:


On April 30, 1956 the applicant was advised by letter that this office contemplated a field investigation and hearing in the matter of Application No. 16806. In this letter applicant was requested to contact this office if they were still interested in the water filing. No answer was received.

On August 30, 1956 the applicant was notified by certified mail that this office had been advised that the Corporation was no longer interested in the filing. However, they were advised that if they were still interested to contact the State Engineer immediately and he would set a date for the field investigation and hearing. The letter was returned to this office unclaimed and with the notation from the Post Office "Box Closed. Moved - left no address".

RULING

Application 16806 is herewith denied on grounds that the applicant is no longer interested in said filing in that they have left no forwarding address, and have not contacted this office with regard to the application.
