

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS NOS.
17350 AND 17359, FILED AUGUST 13,
1957 AND AUGUST 19, 1957, RESPEC-
TIVELY, BY EVERETT L. STOREY, TO
APPROPRIATE WATERS IN NYE COUNTY
(PAHRUMP ARTESIAN BASIN) FOR
IRRIGATION PURPOSES.

RULING

General:

107
Because of a limited water supply in the area, it is the policy of this office, in cooperation with the Bureau of Land Management, to issue permits on Class One land only. Desert Land Entries filed by the applicant to cover the lands proposed to be irrigated under these applications have been rejected by the Bureau of Land Management, on the basis that the soils are sub-marginal and not suitable for agricultural entry.

RULING

Applications Nos. 17350 and 17359 are hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant does not have land on which to place the water to beneficial use.
