INTRODUCTION

Application 36075 was filed to appropriate the underground waters of the State of Nevada in Long Valley, Washoe County, Nevada.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

Application 36075 was filed by Aero Engineering, Inc. and L.B.M. Properties on October 23, 1978, to appropriate 1.5 c.f.s. of underground water for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, T. 21 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use is the W $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Lots 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 of Section 6, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 20 N., R. 18 E., and Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12, Section 31, and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 21 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M. 1/

II.

The State Engineer held a public hearing on May 21, 1982, to collect information concerning the designation of Long Valley, Washoe County, near Bordertown, Nevada. The notice of this hearing referred to Application 36075 and stated that the applicant may submit any additional information to support his application at the hearing. 2/

III.

The applicant and his agents were duly notified of the hearing dated May 21, 1982, in which additional information was requested to support his application. 3/

IV.

Neither the applicant nor his agents attended the hearing held on May 21, 1982, at which additional information and evidence was requested. 4/

V.

No written request for postponement of this hearing was received by the State Engineer. To this date no additional written information has been submitted in support of Application 36075. 5/


CONCLUSION
