

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 17465
FILED ON JANUARY 23, 1958, BY RICHARD W.
COMBS TO APPROPRIATE UNDERGROUND WATER
FOR IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC PURPOSES IN
ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

Application No. 17465 was filed to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. of underground water, within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 21, T. 34 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M. A protest to the granting of this application was filed on June 9, 1958, by the Pershing County Water Conservation District, on grounds that its granting would affect the water table and drainage in its vicinity and thereby adversely affect decreed water rights on the Humboldt River. It is the opinion of the State Engineer that the decreed water rights on the Humboldt River will not be adversely affected.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 17465 is herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.
