RULING

Application No. 10806 was filed April 9, 1942 by Michael J. Hennessy to appropriate 0.05 c.f.s. of underground water for domestic and irrigation purposes. The proposed point of diversion is in Lot 14 Block 1 Highland Park and water was to be pumped from an existing well.

No protest was made to the granting of a permit under this application.

The well proposed to be pumped from under Application No. 10806 is the same well from which water is to be pumped from under Permit No. 10797 in name of Henry Studwell. Our records indicate that Henry Studwell has assigned his permit No. 10797 to the Highland Park Water Association, an association organized to distribute water to the entire tract.

It appearing that the granting of a permit to applicant Michael Hennessy would be detrimental to the public welfare, it is our opinion that said Application No. 10806 should be denied.

RULING

Application No. 10806 is herewith denied on the grounds that the granting thereof would be detrimental to public interests.
