

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO.
17292, FILED BY MYRTLE E. HOLLIDAY,
TO APPROPRIATE WATER FROM AN UNDER-
GROUND SOURCE, FOR IRRIGATION AND
DOMESTIC PURPOSES, IN HUMBOLDT
COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

70 A protest to the granting of this applica-
tion was filed on September 25, 1957, by the Pershing
County Water Conservation District, on grounds that
the granting of this application would affect the
water table and drainage and adversely affect the
decreed water rights on the Humboldt River.

A field investigation in the matter of this
application was made on June 6, 1959. From said
investigation, it was found the granting of this
application would not adversely affect the waters of
the Humboldt River.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application
No. 17292 is hereby overruled on grounds that its
granting will not impair the value of existing rights
or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

A permit will be issued under said applica-
tion upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
