

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO.  
18301, FILED AUGUST 27, 1959, BY  
GUY GARLAND SMITH TO APPROPRIATE  
THE WATER OF AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE  
FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES, IN NYE  
COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

230 Application No. 18301 was filed in support of Desert  
Land Application No. Nevada 032741. On June 2, 1960, we  
were notified by the Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada,  
that they had cancelled the land application. As of the date  
of this ruling, the applicant does not have control of the  
land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use.

RULING

Application No. 18301 is hereby denied on grounds that  
the applicant does not have control of the land on which he  
plans to place the water to beneficial use and that its  
granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
